Teacher led bespoke intervention according to pupils' needs (based on pupil progress meetings, discussion with class teachers)	<p>Teacher led intervention – 1 day a week working with small groups and individual pupils for English and Maths - £10,000 approximately</p> <p>TA led interventions directed by the class teacher for Maths and English</p>	Data shows that 80% of PP children in Year 2 (4/5 pupils) made expected or above progress at the end of the year. 80% of Year 2 children were at Age Related Expectations / Greater Depth at the end of the year.
Objective 2: Speech and Language		
ELKLAN Speech and Language	ELKLAN trained TAs delivering bespoke speech and language interventions £1000 per year	6 pupils were part of this intervention. All made expected progress or above in speaking and 5/6 pupils made expected or above progress in listening and attention. The majority of pupils made a Good Level of Development at the end of the year.
