What is bullying?

- Bullying is **intentional** – the bully is doing it on purpose.
- Bullying is **repetitive** – the bully is hurting someone over and over again.
- Bullying is **targeted** – the bully is finding the same person to hurt.

If you are being bullied:

- TELL SOMEONE
- Be assertive. Use your words and body language to tell the bully to stop
- Walk away
- Ignore them



Who can I tell if I am being bullied?

- An adult in school
- A parent or person who looks after you
- A school council member
- Anybody you trust

What should I do if I see someone else being bullied?

- TELL SOMEONE
- Tell the bully to stop if you feel safe to do so
- Don't ignore it

What will happen to a bully?

- The adults in school will investigate
- The adults will follow the behaviour policy
- The teachers will speak to the bully and the bully's parents

Our responsibilities:

We will **all** work together to make sure everyone in our school is safe and happy.
