
Development Matters

The Unique Child reaches out to relate to people and things through the Characteristics of Effective Learning, which move through all areas of learning.

- playing and exploring
- active learning

Children develop in the context of relationships and the environment around them.

Starts from the child's experience & within the EYFS curriculum




A mix of planned & purposeful play

5. Relationships


Includes lessons on Friendship, Family and other Relationships, Conflict Resolution, Communication, Loss and Bereavement.

- An individual reading book which will be changed every Monday


Children will also be allowed to borrow one library book every Friday


